



4th Collaborative Call between Brazil & European Union will be explained during ICT Week 2016

On 20th September, the rules for the 4th collaborative call between BR-EU, will be announced in Brasília during a workshop organised by MCTIC & European Commission, at ICTWeek 2016.

Policy event to support International Collaboration in IoT, 5G & Cloud Computing

Rules for the 4th collaborative call between Brazil and the European Union will be announced in Brasilia, on 20th September, during a workshop at ICTWeek 2016, event organised by Brazilian Ministry of Science, Technology, Innovation and Communication (MCTIC) and European Commission (EC), from 20th to 23rd September.

ICTWeek 2016 will gather together Policy members from Brazil ([Maximiliano Martinhão](#) from MCTIC) and Europe (Jorge Pereira from EC), as well as researchers and industry members (e.g. Lisandro Granville, from Brazil's National Education and Research Network "RNP" and President of Brazilian Computer Society "SBC").

For the RNP project coordinator, [Wanderson Paim](#), "this call is a step further to consolidate the partnership between Brazil and EU in the ICT sector. International Cooperation is highly beneficial, since it promotes the creation of new partnerships and information exchange between researchers and industry, both interested in ICT development. Results have been acceptable, which makes us believe that we are on the right track".

Researchers will be able to pitch their proposals, highlighting their project's main goals close to industry, academia and policy experts. The workshop is also an opportunity to find partners for their proposals.

All candidates can get as well **useful information from previous funded projects**, which will showcase their preliminary results at the workshop. Focused on Cloud Computing and High Performance Computing, these projects benefited from a €7 million fund which will allow them to innovate BR-EU economies.

The 4th collaborative call will be announced during the Policy Dialogue between Brazil & Europe planned for November 2016 and all proposals must clearly showcase how it will benefit citizens, cities, business and economy between Brazil and Europe, even after the conclusion of the project.
